




EU RF and the post-2015 framework

- SDG targets being finalised (SG report to be released end of Nov); SDG target indicators to be agreed in the course of 2015 at the earliest.
- Strong link between EU RF and current SDGs and related targets: 16 out of 17 SDGs covered by the EU RF (EU policy priorities).
- First review of the EU RF to take place in 2016 when SDG targets and indicators will be defined.



EU RF Data source & data collection

Coverage

- Results reported for Projects and Programmes above 750,000 EUR (bilateral, regional, thematic).
- Instruments covered: DCI, EDF, Stability and Peace, Democracy and Human rights, Nuclear safety, Greenland (2014-2020) and corresponding countries for 2007-2013*.


* First years of reporting will reflect actions from previous programming period.

To facilitate and ensure coherence in measurement each RF indicator will be accompanied by a **methodological note** describing the following issues : relevance for EU policy, data sources, disaggregation, method of calculation and worked examples.




Level 2: Results Reporting

- Results reporting (level 2) based on completed projects.
- Ongoing reporting possibly to be introduced in the future following upgrade of internal monitoring.
- Results data consolidated into Completion Reports by EU operational managers in Delegations and HQ and transmitted to HQ services.
- HQ services to perform final quality check and aggregation.



Level 2: Results calculation

- Results to be reported as "partner country results supported by the EU" - Contribution approach.
- Overall method applied to calculate results: total of results achieved by EU interventions jointly with partners (including BS and other co-funded operations).
- Proportional method to be explored in the future.



Level 1: Results aggregation


- Yearly aggregation of RF indicators
- Level 1:** Data aggregated across ALL countries where EuropeAid has ongoing interventions (approx. 100)

Example: Access to electricity (% of population having access to electricity) aggregated across all 100 countries (weighted average based on population)

Level 2: Results aggregation

- **Level 2:** Data aggregated **ONLY** across countries where EuropeAid has interventions contributing to the specific indicator

Example: "Transmission/distribution lines upgraded (km)" aggregated only for countries where EU is financing the Energy sector and, within Energy, lines construction



Baselines and Targets

Baselines

- Level 1 – Latest available data points
- Level 2 – Baseline set at zero for 2014
- Level 3 – Latest available data points

Targets

- No corporate targets set for Level 1 and 2
- Level 3 – Targets set as indicated in EuropeAid Management Plan or as part of international commitments

EURF & Publication of results

- **Once a year:** publication in EuropeAid annual report of **aggregated numbers** against the corporate results framework (high level numbers)
- **Occasionally:** publication of **country pages** (more context-specific results)
