My background is in environmental engineering and water resources management (MSc). I gained a sound knowledge of the water relevant national and international legislation and challenges through my ongoing work for the Ministry as well as in International River Commissions. On national and river basin district level I was involved in drafting River Basin Management Plans and Climate Change Adaptation Strategies.

Main water management issues in Austria are ecologically sound hydropower generation and sustainable agricultural production. Water is the key conjunctive element of several economic sectors, which is perfectly reflected by the concept of the Water-Energy-Food nexus and also the UN Agenda 2030. Current challenges with the availability of water in sufficient quality and quantity for all uses are aggravating worldwide, especially due to climate change.
