

DEAR Fair: Projects showcased their work on engaging Europeans in global change

The Development Education and Awareness Raising (DEAR) programme aims to develop European citizens awareness of the interdependent world, and to support active engagement in global attempts to eradicate poverty, promote justice, human rights and sustainable ways of living.

The first ever DEAR Fair attracted over 80 exhibiting projects from all over Europe covering topics such as living wage for garment workers, just production and consumption of raw materials, sustainble fishing policies and corporate tax evasion. More than 170 participants from different stakeholders including Civil Society Organisations, Local Authorities, European Institutions, EU Member State officials and academia attended. Development Education and Awareness Raising Fair

In the framework of the European Year for Development 2015, Commissioner for International Cooperation and Development Neven Mimica will give a keynote speech at the EU's Development Education and Awareness Raising (DEAR) fair on 23 October. The EU Development Education and Awareness Raising (DEAR) Programme Fair will bring together an exhibition of around 80 DEAR projects from all 28 EU Member States. Over the last four years the EU provided approximately €120 million for this Programme. The projects work towards an increased awareness and critical engagement on development issues in the current global context. The fair will consist of an exhibition of development education and awareness raising projects, but will also have a parallel programme consisting of plenary sessions, workshops and presentations. The participation of representatives of approximately 100 Civil Society Organisations (CSO), 20 Local Authorities (LA) as well as participants of EU Institutions, Member States and Academia is also being envisaged. The event will take place over the span of two days and will close at 16:00 on 23 October. It will be housed at the MCE- Conference and Business Centre, Rue de l'Aqueduc 118, 1050, Brussels. 2015 10 22 First Development Education and Awareness Raising fair opens today in Brussels



The EU Development Education and Awareness Raising (DEAR) programme fair opened today in Brussels with the welcome address of Fernando Frutuoso de Melo, Director General for International Cooperation and Development.

The Fair brings together around 80 EU DEAR funded projects from all 28 EU Member States to exhibit their work, network, exchange ideas, and discuss DEAR issues.

Approximately 180 participants will be present over the two days of the event; representing approximately 100 Civil Society Organisations (CSO), 20 local authorities, EU institutions, Member States, and academia. Commissioner Neven Mimica, EU Commissioner for International Cooperation and Development will give a keynote speech tomorrow. Friday 23, October at 09:30.

Over the last four years the EU provided approximately 143 million EUR for the EU DEAR Programme. This programme seeks to inform EU citizens about the interconnectedness of the world and empower them to become critically engaged on global development issues.

The DEAR Fair is linked to the European Year for Development and is particularly relevant in the new Agenda 2030 (Sustainable Development Goals). Target 4.7 specifically makes reference to global citizenship, for sustainable development and lifestyles.
