Towards2030-dialogue Final Conference, “*Winter Package 2016: Which Way Forward for Renewables in Europe?*” took place on the 22<sup>th</sup> November 2016 in Brussels, organized by CEPS.

The *first session* introduced Towards2030-dialogue activities, key outcomes and recommendations, while the *second session* took a closer look at the trade-offs between electricity markets and renewables. The different electricity market design elements to improve renewables were analyzed. The *third session* focused on possible approaches of sharing the effort to reach the 2030 RES target of 27%, including clear, self-imposed commitments of each EU Member State.

This *policy event* at the European Parliament presents key results and provides a stage for discussing the way forward, including a first reflection of the EC proposal.
