From Paris to Marrakech and beyond

1. The adoption of the historical Paris Agreement marks a new era of global co-operation to address climate change.
2. Concrete steps must be taken now to achieve climate targets.
3. Paris delivered an agreement. Marrakesh must deliver action.
4. Climate Action is development action. Therefore, linkages between climate action and (sustainable) development action must be understood, articulated and integrated in planning; delivering and measuring action.

From Paris to Marrakech and beyond

5. Action on climate change must be inclusive, gender-responsive and must prioritize the poorest and most vulnerable
6. A dual approach to mitigation and adaptation is essential: those already being impacted by climate change must be supported.
7. Continued support to national leadership is essential.
8. Adequate finance is essential.
9. Innovative partnerships are critical
