The Centre for National Defence Studies (CESEDEN) and the European Security and Defence College (ESDC) have the honour of co-organising the CSDP Orientation Course to be held in Madrid, Spain, from the 27th to the 31st of March 2017.

The CSDP Orientation Course is one of the top courses of the ESDC. The course aims to provide the participants with a general overview of the CSDP and getting into more detail on the most pertinent issues on the current European security and defence policy agenda.

The course consists of an **eLearning part**, as well as a **residential session**, held in Madrid, Spain, both parts being compulsory. Participants will also have the opportunity to network, share views and perspectives with one another and with professionals in the field of CSDP.*

This specific Orientation Course will focus on how the EU and its member states could face the unconventional and unrestricted warfare.

We would like to invite you to nominate participants for the CSDP Orientation Course, which would offer them an excellent opportunity to gain an insight into CSDP and contribute to achieving the ultimate goal of the course: providing Member States and EU institutions with knowledgeable personnel, able to work in CSDP related fields at strategic level.

Administrative instructions CSDP Orientation Course

Hosted by the CESEDEN

Madrid, 27th – 31st March 2017

- The course is open to both civilian and military personnel from EU Member States, EU Institutions and Agencies, which are each one invited to nominate up to two participants.
- All lectures will be imparted in English without translation.
- Attendance of the course is mandatory on all days. A certificate will be awarded to those course participants who have completed the full course, including the eLearning phase.
- The sending authorities shall cover all costs for travelling, accommodation and catering.
- Applications are to be filed via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST (https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/ENList/web/app.php/login) by designated nominators. The deadline is February 20th, 2017.
- Registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat and upon completion of the registration form by the nominated participant.
- A reception on Monday, March 27th 2017, will be hosted by CESEDEN.
- The course will start with the eLearning- phase. The residential part of the course will take place in Madrid at CESEDEN from the 27th till the 31st March 2017.
