What are potential challenges/risks linked to the proof concept	In our country there is high electricity power cuts being experienced which has made the supply of power very unreliable.
Challenge/Risk-mitigation measures: How can we overcome them? Please, explain.	The proposed venue has an electric generator that can be used as backup to power cut though the cost of lubricants (fuel- petrol) is high in the country.
Additional information	The training is proposed to take place in a rural settings and the local school classrooms will be used though at a small fee. Participants will be coming from their as coming from their homes and no lodging/accommodation will be need. However, meals (teas/snacks and lunch) will be necessary for them. The Local Co-facilitator will need food and transport (Lunch and transport allowance) as she is based at Chadiza Boma some few kilometers away from the training venue. Note: The proposed number of participants is 150 (75 women and 75 men) against 10 computers. Therefore, the ideal training sessions will be about 4(each having 35 participants). Meaning the total period of the training will be 20 days. Important to take note also is that the Zambia Education School Calendar runs from January to March, May to July and September to November. Therefore the ideal training time would be December,

NB: This Training Package will be delivered by our international training expert for free. The local Partner organization is in charge of the local facility and accommodations. We could offer live/online training package from 5-150 participants.
