
## Awareness raising

- ✓ Make C2-C6 support services better known
- ✓ Presence on Capacity4Dev pages
- ✓ E-Newsletters (2)
- ✓ Direct engagement with 40 'priority Delegations' (38 VCs), use of country follow-up sheets
  - *Engage with less traditional channels (blending, budget support, policy dialogue)*

## Capacity development

- ✓ More flexible and tailored training (ex. Lesotho) – on demand
- ✓ Cooperation among facilities (ECCM, GCCA, B4Life, S2G)
- ✓ Participate in developing and delivering training:
  - Greening EU development cooperation (2)
  - Greening national development (3)
  - Inclusive Green Economy (4)
  - Thematic AFS seminars (2)
- ***Explore opportunities for joint training / seminars***
- *Use of other tools - short videos, webinars*

# Tools, procedures



- ✓ Revised Guidelines, Sector Notes (3 final)
- ✓ Compilation of CEPs, REPs, SEAs, EIAs (Cap4Dev)
- ✓ Booklet on SEA, others to follow (CfP, xx?)
- ✓ Study of linkages migration- climate change

- *Document good practice (cases)*
- *Develop other tools - short videos, webinars*

## Ad-hoc support

- ✓ Requests (32) from HQ (2/3) and DEL (1/3)....
  - ✓ Includes support for SEA processes (SZ, UG, KH), country support mission (HT)
  - ✓ Increasing pre-QSG consultation
- *Engage with the MT review process (regional, national)*

## Review operations (QSG)

- ✓ reviewed 373 Action Documents (QSG Checklists, ADs) QSG1-2
  - ✓ Increasing inputs other Facilities
  - ✓ Focus on '**priority sectors**' (agriculture, food/nutrition security and rural development; private sector development; energy; transport and infrastructure; water, sanitation and waste management)
  - ✓ But other sectors not to be ignored... (governance-PFM, health, education)...
- *Challenge: funding flows outside of regular QS process (Investment)*

## Finance tracking

- ✓ Use Policy/Rio markers to monitor and report on the ODA flows for environment and Rio-themes --
- ✓ Quality control of Rio-marker scores - OECD DAC report
- ✓ DEVCO commitments in 2015: 385 commitments - 8,1 B EUR--
- ✓ Detailed analysis (2014, 2015, 2016 ongoing)  
by financing instruments, type of flow (ODA, non-ODA, DCI-other), sectors, geographical areas and countries, etc.
- ✓ Achievements to date in next slides
  - *Challenge; to respond quickly to different data requests*

Policy markers to monitor and report on the development finance flows targeting the Rio Conventions:

- Aid to Environment
- Biodiversity
- Desertification
- Climate Change Mitigation
- Climate Change Adaptation



During the quality control of the Rio markers, a need to revise some of the scores was identified, in line with the justifications presented below.			
	CRIS	PROPOSED	JUSTIFICATION
Aid to Environment	2	2	Validated
Biodiversity	0	0	Validated
Desertification	0	1	The project makes reference to combat land degradation and loss of arable lands, thus we suggest upgrading the score from 0 to 1.
Climate change mitigation	1	1	Validated
Climate change adaptation	1	2	We suggest upgrading this Rio marker from 1 to 2, in line with the example provided in the recent OECD-DAC guidance on Rio marking for climate change: 'Water resources conservation is particularly important for climate-resilience, especially if an assessment of climate change risks include water shortages or high fluctuations in available water resources. In this specific case, adaptation score 2 may be appropriate'.


## Contributions to Aid to Environment

DCI Regulation 2014-2020: *At least 50% of the funds, prior to the use of the markers based on OECD methodology, will serve for climate action and environment-related objectives.*



## Contributions to Climate Change


Objective: *The EU is committed to dedicate 20% of its 2014-2020 budget for climate change mitigation and adaptation actions*





DCI Commitments - Climate change




EDF Commitments - Climate change




## Contributions to Biological Diversity
