





## Qualifications

- Represents a regional/global network re. int'l cooperation & development
- Has adequate regional contacts to reach wide membership
- Able to disseminate information/communications on PFD issues

## Organisational Representatives

- Relevant expertise of PFD issues
- Able to express constituencies' views & provide feedback thereto
- Able to communicate effectively in English, French or Spanish

## Commitments

- Participate in PFD-related activities and communications
- Undertake outreach and gather feedback around PFD issues
- Represent the views of their constituencies

## Appointment

- Appointed organisations (the "Members of the PFD") select own representatives
- NGO member selection differs according to region
- Global networks selected according to engagement with the Structured Dialogue and their worldwide coverage in various constituencies

- 2 years + 2 years (+ for protection of institutional memory)

- 2 years + 2 years (+ for protection of institutional memory)




