Brief description of the project: Sensitisation and valorisation on the extraction of Sapphire in River Mbven directly below the government high school Mbiame where there exist a very large reserve – Mbven subdivision. There exist currently 56 functional artisanal miners specialised in Semi-precious and precious stones specifically Sapphire in the locality, only the youthful population is involve in the activity. Due to the recent recording of numerous working related accidents, and other health and safety related issues in the community, this project seeks to address such constrains as well as how they can be tackled

## Expected results:

- Mobilizing the young artisans to participate in environmental and natural resource management for health, safety and increased sustainable livelihoods.
- ➤ To organize and recognize young artisan groups/organizations by linking them with socioeconomic opportunities available national or international wise.
- > To encourage young artisans to join themselves so as to participate in a wide range of activities appropriate to their age and stage of development in regards to mining activities.
