Brief Description of the project:

"PROMOTION OF SEMI-PRECIOUS STONE DEVELOPMENT IN AMUDAT DISTRICT"

The aim of the project is to establish a Model semi-Precious stone Club in Amudat district, in order to promote the development of semi-precious stones mining in the region for social and economic development. The objectives include: training miners on value addition techniques; sensitize miners on best practices in mining, conflict resolution, environment, health and safety; identify various varieties of gemstones in the area and generate a base map (map showing locations of the various semi-precious stones) in so doing attract more investors in the sector; acquire a lapidary for both the Club and DGSM.

Through the Model club established, members will be provided with safety gear; equipped with marketing and entrepreneur skills that will harness more returns on the commodity sale and promotion of their products to the world.

- Identification of various varieties of gemstones in the area

We intend to first carry out literature review in which the geology of the area of study will be carried out. This will be done with technical support from the DGSM technical staff.

During the different site visits, we shall identify the various semi-precious stones available in the area taking note of their locations. In identifying of the various gemstones and their location, we will require GPS and a vehicle. DGSM will provide the GPS and the vehicle however fuel will be required for the vehicle.

Once we arrive in Amudat district, we will report to the police who will ensure our safety in the area and also we shall go to the local government offices where we will interact with the Natural Resource Officer, Community Development Officer and commercial Officer. These personnel from the district will; guide us to the various active sites, provide information on semi-precious stone mining and selling in the area, help in translation from English to the local dialect as we carry out trainings and sensitization of the miners at the various sites and they will for moral and social support.

We shall foster the formulation of a semi-precious stone club that will be model in the region. The leadership of the club will guide in conflict resolutions as per the training.

On acquiring the lapidary for the club and DGSM, we shall hold trainings on equipment operation and maintenance thus gaining skills in value addition with the support from DGSM technical staff.
