INTRODUCTION

Following the resolution passed by UNDP at wash and wills workshop, the activity on identification of artisanal was successfully done as by the TOT members of busia. The four days activity covered three districts of Namayingo, Busia identifying artisanals involved in mining of different development minerals.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- ✓ UNDP should always avail some funds in advance to ease the implementation of this activity.
- ✓ Mobilization of these groups should also be taken seriously which should at least involve radio announcements to reach the population in advance as it may allow early preparations.
- ✓ There is need for a secure means of transport in hard to reach area and travelling forth to the nearest accommodation which is about 6kms away.
- ✓ UNDP should expedite the implementation of this activity since some of the artisans are losing interest in the program and relating it to some failed organizations' programs.

CONCLUSION

Let the long awaited activated therefore be implemented and it is also our humble request to consider all the above groups for training since they have patiently and positively waited.
