



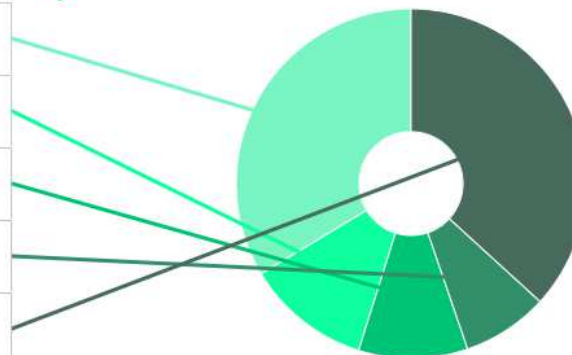

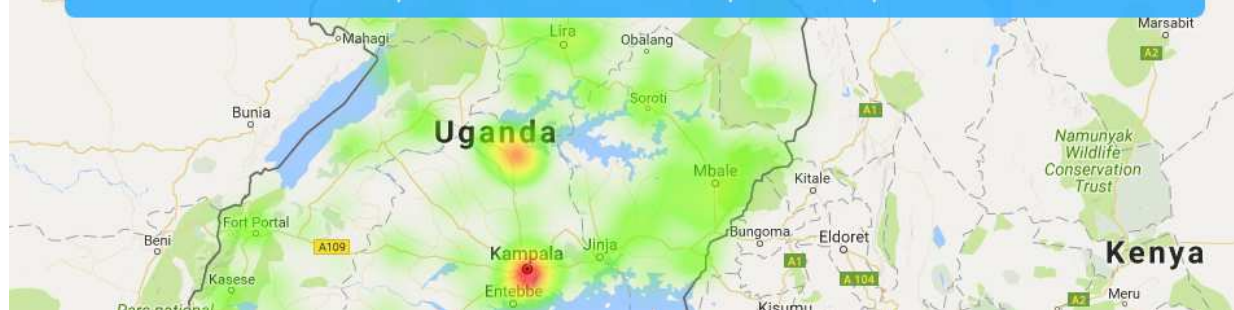

International Aid Transparency Initiative (IATI)

- Launched in Accra (2008) as part of the aid effectiveness agenda
 - Principles of coordination, harmonisation, alignment, etc. – information is crucial to improve the management of aid.
- Political commitment and technical initiative
 - EU involved since the very beginning

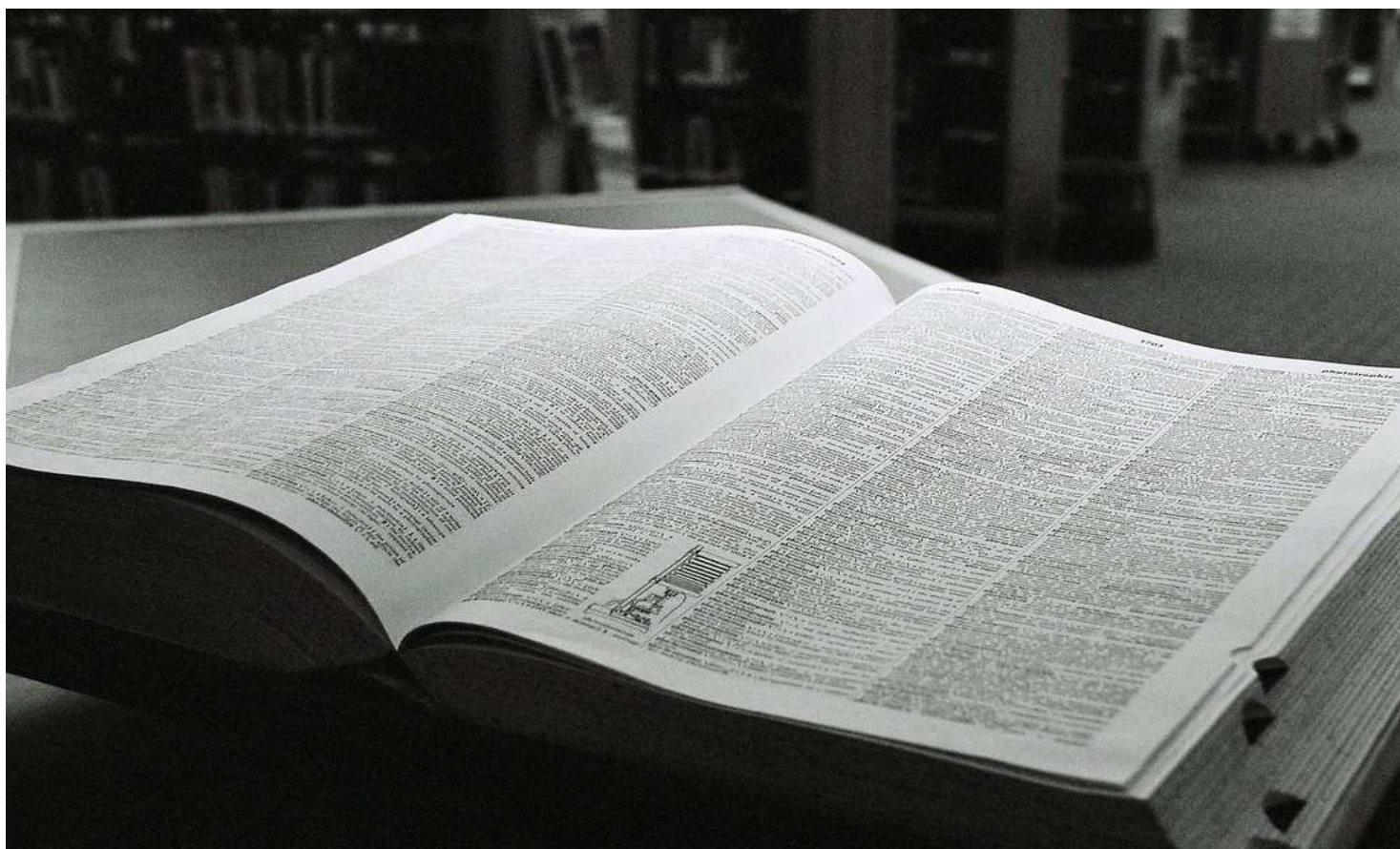

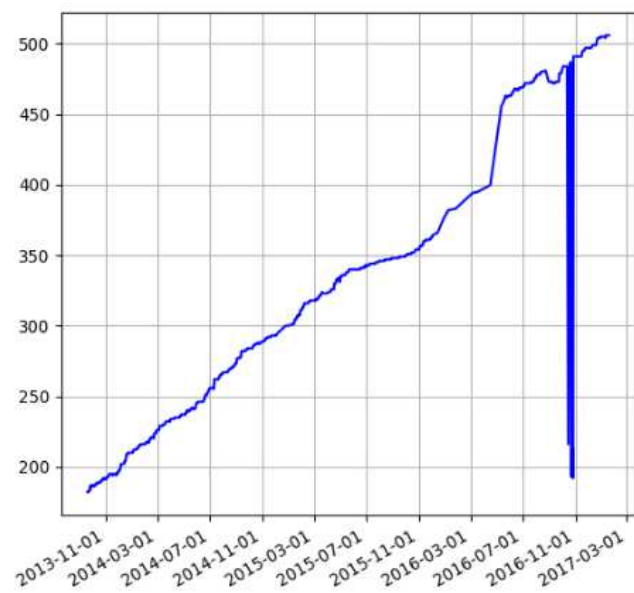

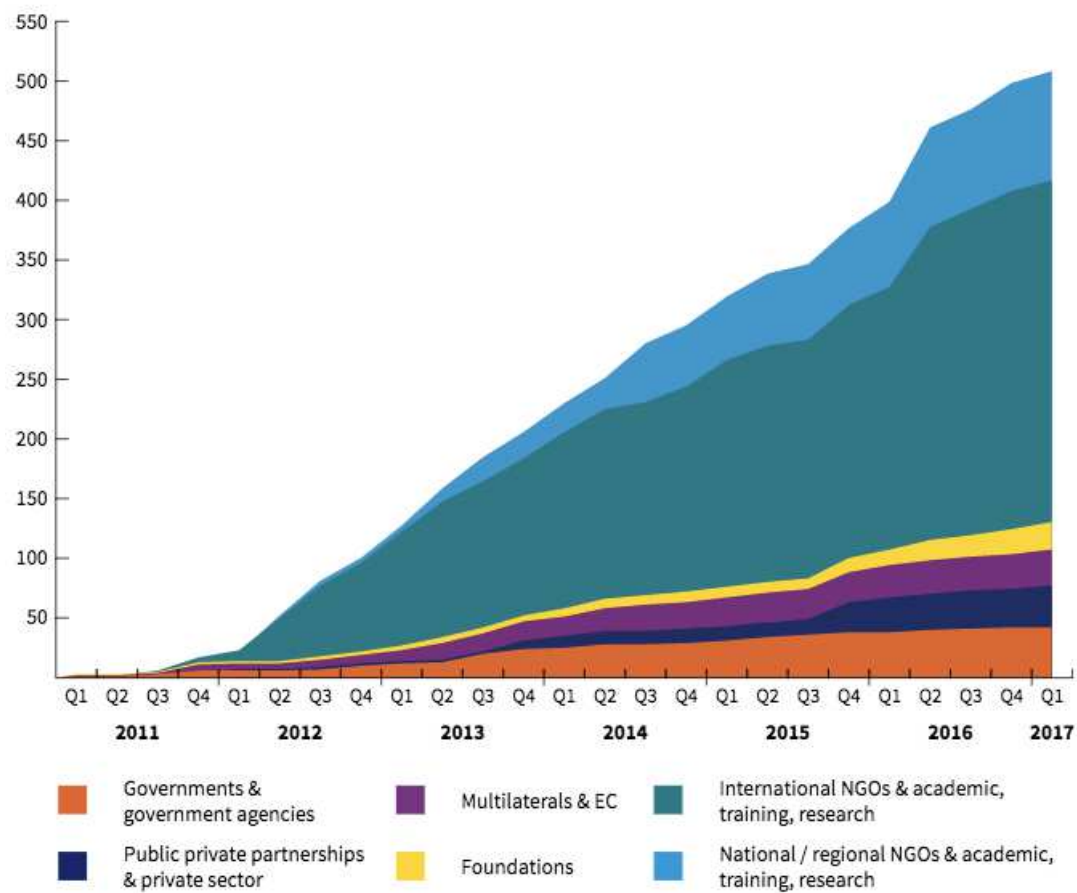

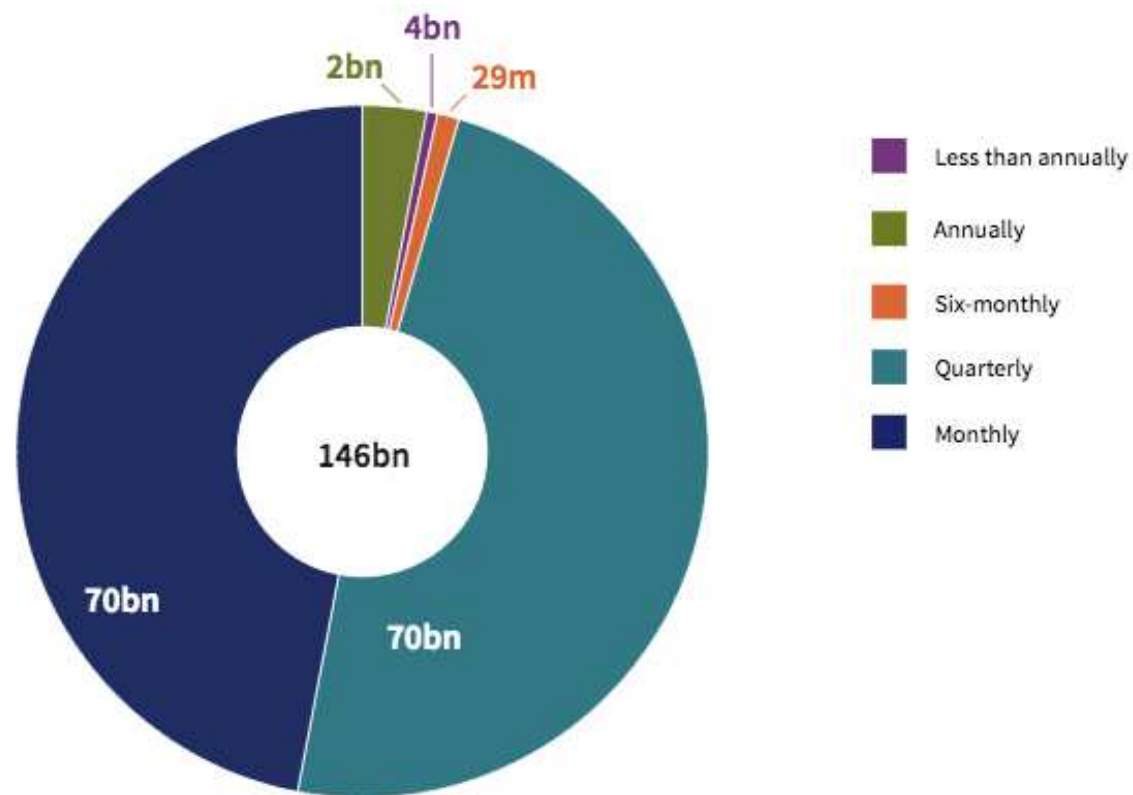
This graph shows the number of organisations publishing IATI data over time.

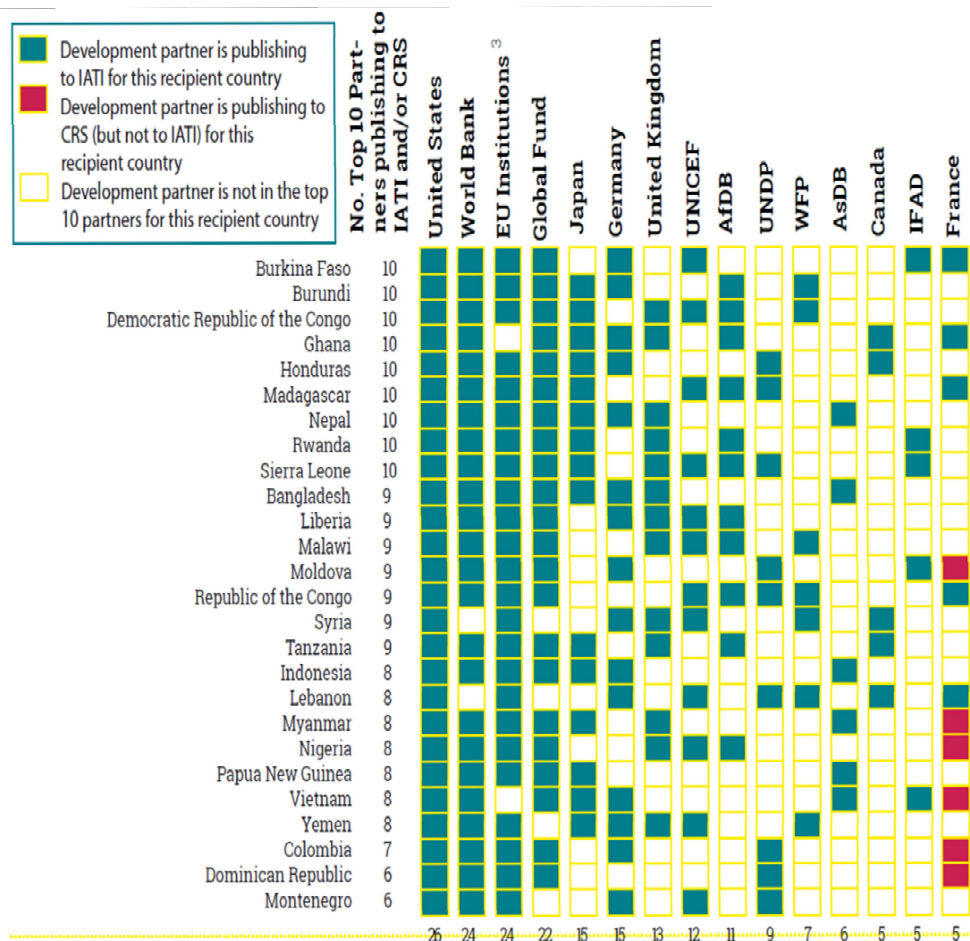

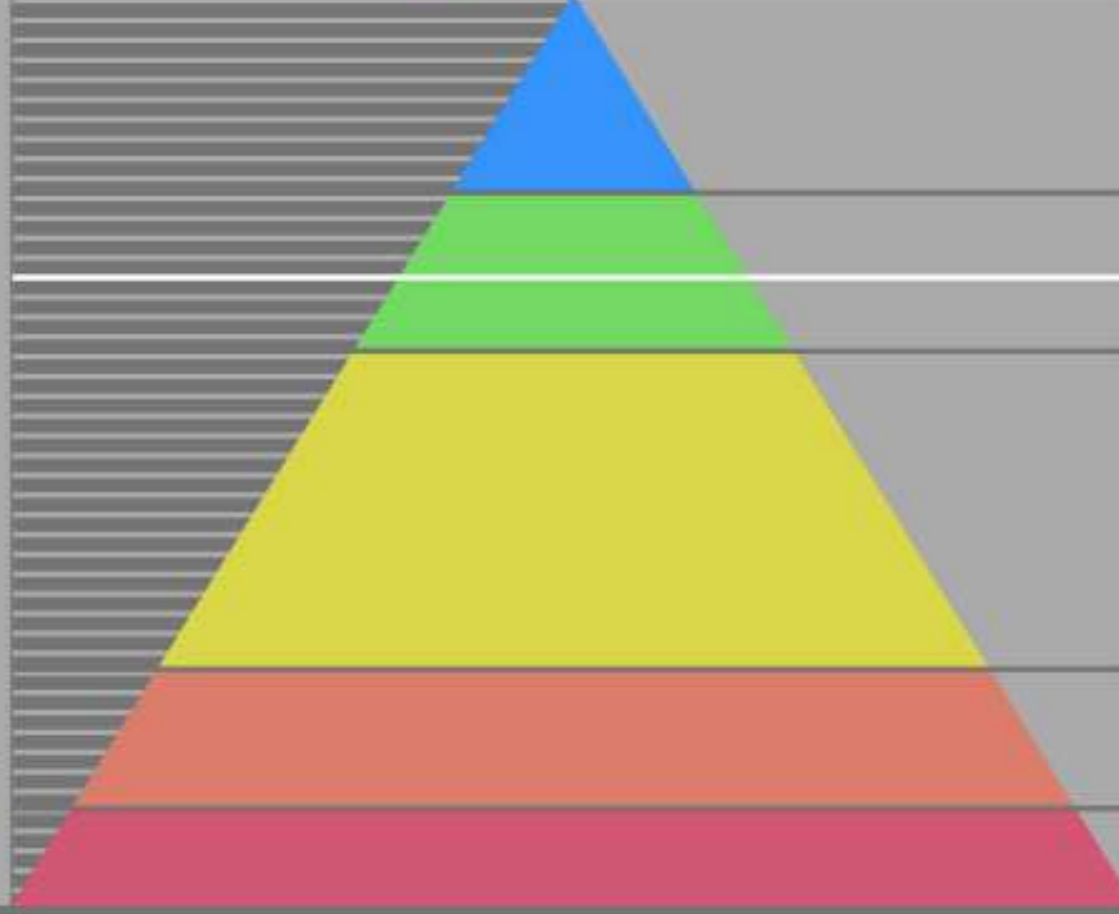

IATI Annual Report key stats

- ↑ **\$146bn** of disbursements and expenditure reported in 2016.
- ↑ **Over 500 IATI publishers** - 40% increase since Annual Report 2015.
- ↑ **Timeliness: 96% (US\$140 billion)** was reported by publishers who update their data at least every quarter, up from **80% in 2015**.
- ↑ **Forward-looking budget data: US\$126 billion** was published for 2017 and 2018, compared to **US\$34 billion** in the last Annual Report (for 2016 and 2017 budgets).
- ↑ **Availability:** IATI data is now available from at least nine out of the ten top development partners for **25 out of 27 Partner Country members** – an increase of **8** since the last annual report.

« DEVCO publishes data to the International Aid Transparency Initiative (IATI) every month. IATI data is designed with user needs in mind, and aims to be timely, comprehensive and forward-looking. It is intended for aid management and scrutiny purposes: to allow partner countries to plan and manage budgets, based on timely and accurate financial data; and parliaments, CSOs and citizens to hold their governments to account. This data comes directly from different information systems (CRIS, ABAC, GIS, PROSPECT, AUDIT, etc) and therefore high quality output depends on high quality input into these systems.»

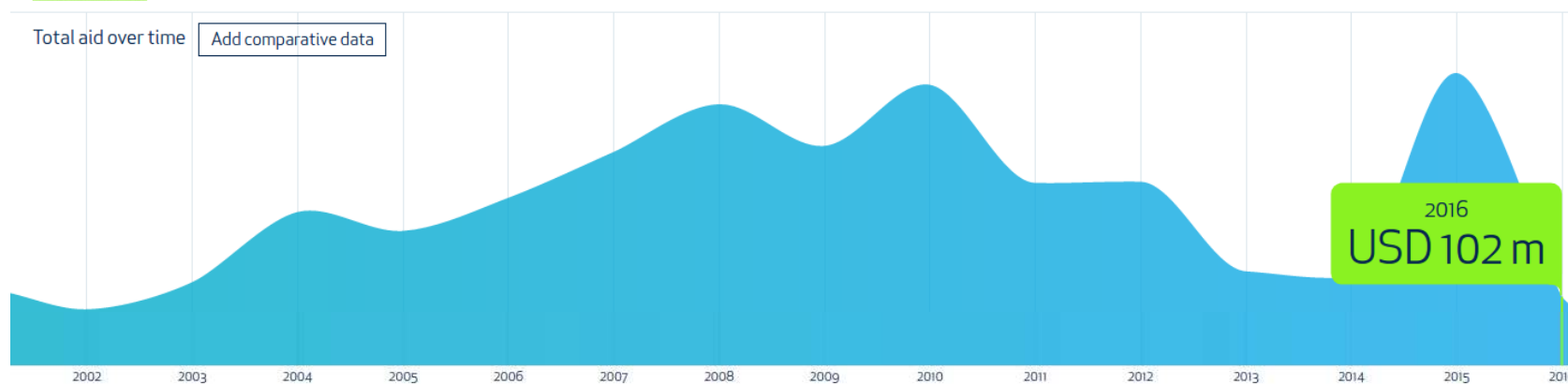

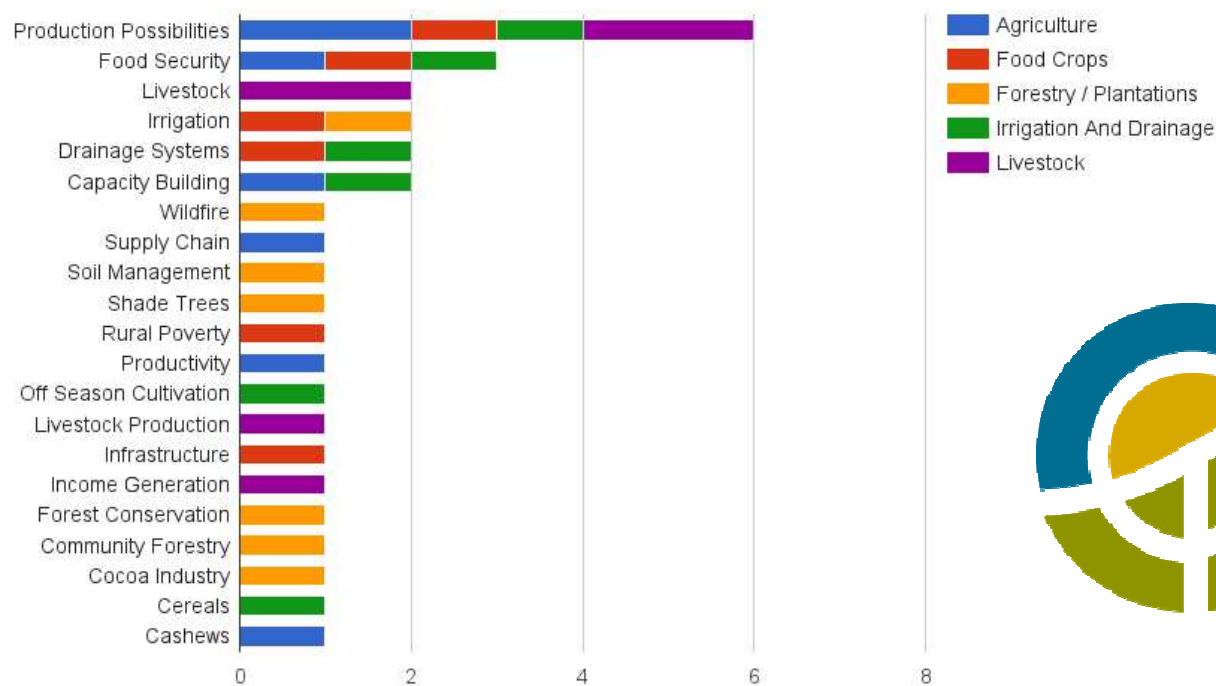

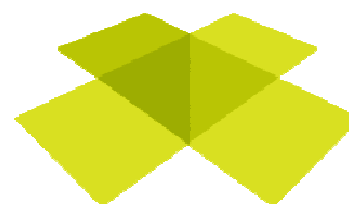


Open Contracting Data Standard (OCDS)

Fig 1. Stages of the contracting process




