Websites that use IATI data

All these websites and projects utilise IATI data. This can be in similar, but also different ways. Take a look through the services to see which you might use. The number of sites and projects using IATI data is growing every day.

Website	Description	Notes
EU Aid Explorer	Access analysis and infographics. Browse and filter all projects. Uses data from multiple sources, including IATI. See: https://euaidexplorer.ec.europa.eu/	
D-Portal	Uses all IATI data, from every publisher. Refreshes every night. Provides country, sector and publisher aggregations. See: http://d-portal.org	
DevTracker (DFID)	UK government website. Refreshes monthly. Centres on DFID data, but uses partner data. See: https://devtracker.dfid.gov.uk	
Open Aid Sida	Sweden government website. Uses Sweden data only. Very visual approach. See: https://openaid.se	

Open Aid NL	<p>Netherlands government website. Uses Minbuza data. Provides breakdowns by country, sector and organisation.</p> <p>See: https://www.openaid.nl/</p>	
Canada Project Browser	<p>Canadian government website. Enables browsing and searching, plus downloads.</p> <p>See: http://w05.international.gc.ca/projectbrowser-banqueprojets/?lang=eng</p>	
UNICEF Transparency Portal	<p>Provides analysis and access to UNICEF projects.</p> <p>See: http://open.unicef.org/</p>	
UNESCO Transparency Portal	<p>Browse, visualise and search UNESCO projects.</p> <p>See: https://opendata.unesco.org/</p>	
Cordaid projects	<p>Dutch NGO. Entire site is built with IATI data</p> <p>See: https://www.cordaid.org/en/projects/</p>	
Aid Transparency Index	<p>Annual scrutiny of donor transparency. Places heavy emphasis on quality of data published by IATI data.</p> <p>See: http://ati.publishwhatyoufund.org/</p>	
Aidstream	<p>An online data entry tool that allows publishers to enter their information through a simple form, and generate IATI data.</p> <p>See: http://www.aidstream.org/</p>
