SPHIP objectives

- The overall objective of the programme is to **protection and promotion of population's health** through **policy analysis and policy advice**.
 - Improve Universal Health Coverage
- The specific objective of the programme is to **enhance expertise, knowledge and resources** of selected **schools of public health** or **public health research institutes** in **low-income countries**

Background SPHIP

- Health systems strengthening in low-income countries is needed for formulation of evidence-based policies
 - Showing added value of local research
- Multi-country initiative for effective mutual learning and resource mobilisation
- Building South-South networks for exchange of practices and experiences

Selected projects

- Projects selected in eight countries
 - Africa: Burundi, Dem. Rep. Congo, Kenya, Uganda
 - Asia: Bangladesh, Lao PDR, Myanmar
 - Caribbean: Haiti
- Partners in Southern countries and in European countries
- Projects for 5 years 2015 - 2020

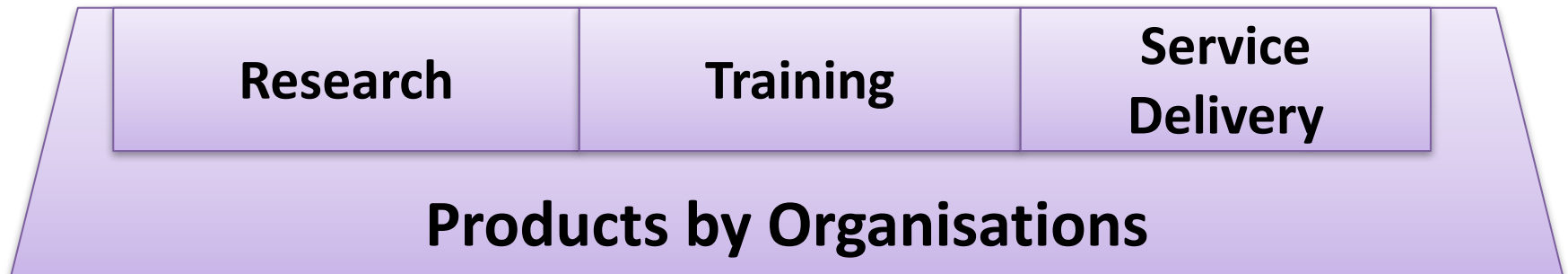

 - Quality assurance systems

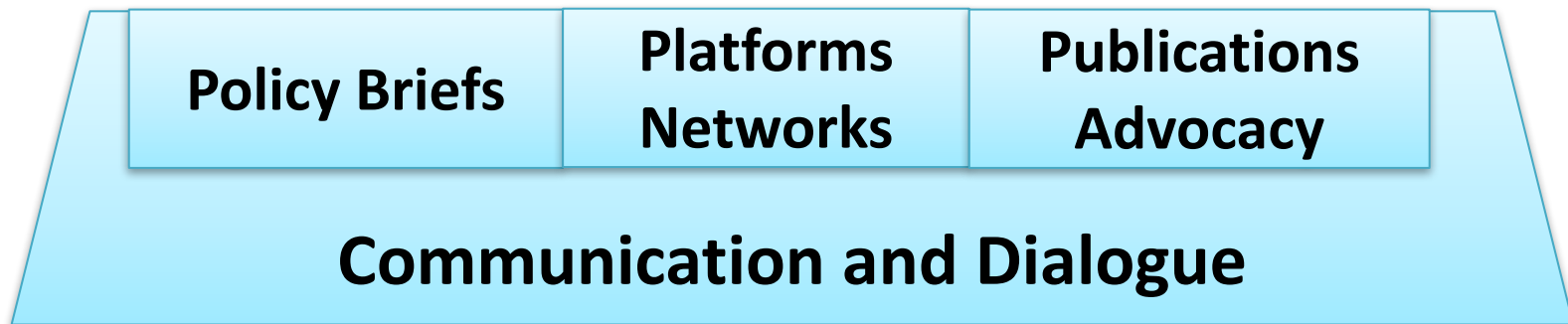

Examples of policy advice in SPHIP

- Universal Health Coverage
 - Formulation of national UHC policy in Uganda
 - Formulation of strategy for reaching urban poor with NCD interventions in Bangladesh
 - Formulation of national NCD policy and strategy in Myanmar
 - Advice for healthcare financing strategy in DR Congo
- Global Health Security Agenda
 - Formulation of national health laboratory policy and strategy in Haiti

Examples of implementation research and database analysis

- Monitoring of policy implementation using comprehensive mixed method methodology in Uganda and Lao PDR
- Data for Decision approach in Bangladesh, developing dashboard for monitoring service delivery
- Community based monitoring in Kenya
- National Health Observatory functions in Uganda, DR Congo and Burundi
