Opportunities of DAC statistics (1)

- CPA seems to be the right concept for DoL
- Support to NGO's have been filtered out as much as possible; can be further done on individual basis
- DAC can provide commitments (for picture of future) and disbursements
- Adaptation for local sector definitions seems feasible

Opportunities of DAC statistics (2)

- Rural development (often a sector) can be singled out from multi-sector
- Regional programs (across countries) do not show up in country data
- Mapping overview in Excel for all FT DoL

What DAC can't (yet) offer

- No separate data for the regional level (within a country), but do we need it?
- Detail on aid modalities (only General Budget Support)
- More recent data, always time lag between 9-21 months
(role for IATI, more frequent DAC/CRS, AIMS, TR-AID)

Next steps 1

1. TS agrees DAC matrices to be used for FT DoL:
 - Monitoring
 - Support decision making

Next steps 2

2. Common strategic approach by each lead facilitator:

- Adapt sector tables for local sectors based on national development plan (together with DAC)
- Include matrix for commitments (also adapted to local sector definitions)
- Add comparative advantage as locally agreed or use sectors as defined in donor CSPs
- Share with other EU MS and government (and other donors)
- Develop proposals for sector involvement (entry/increase/delegated cooperation/exit)
