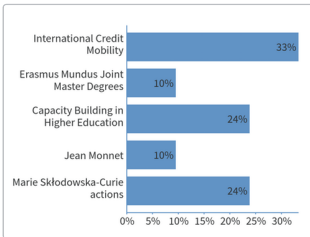

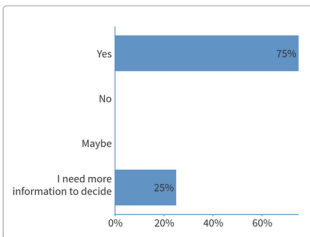

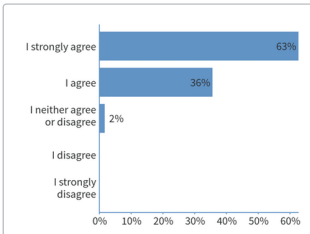

4. The EU is an important partner for Indonesian education exchanges.

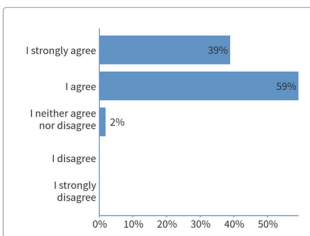

5. The workshop improved my understanding of the EU opportunities in Education



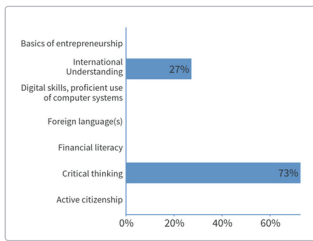

7. What are the two most important skills Education institutions should equip students with?

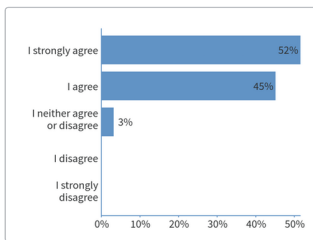

8. I feel that studying or researching in the European Union will increase Indonesian student's chances of finding a job in Indonesia after graduation

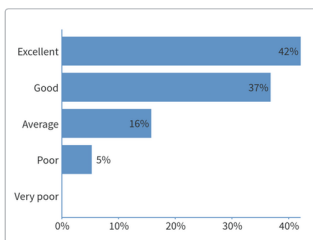

9. What is your overall rating of today's workshop?

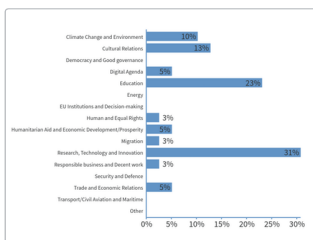

10. What other topics would you like to discuss with the EU?

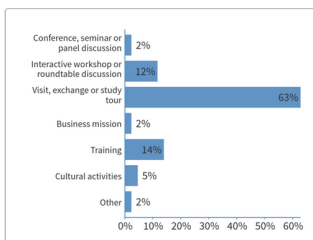

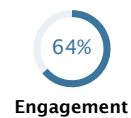
