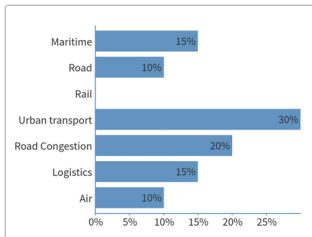

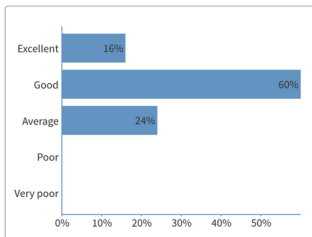

Pre-discussion. What are the most important challenges in the transport sector in Indonesia?



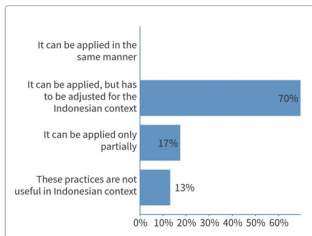

Pre-discussion. How well do you think the EU performs in its transport policies?



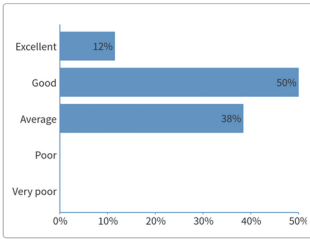

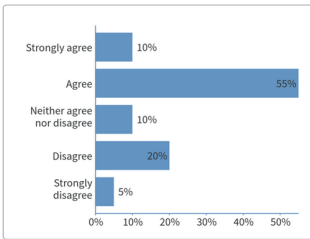

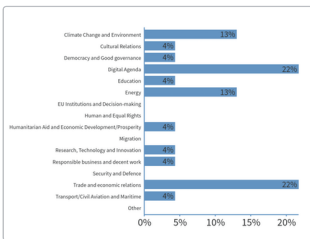

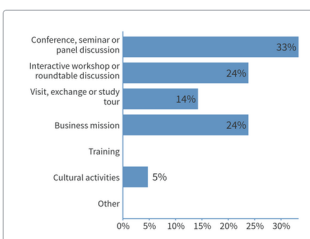

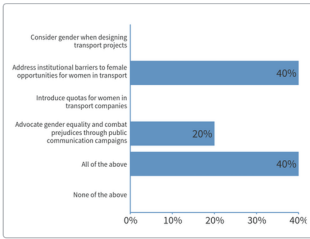

In which of the following EU-related activities would you be interested in taking part in?



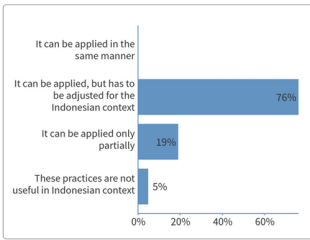

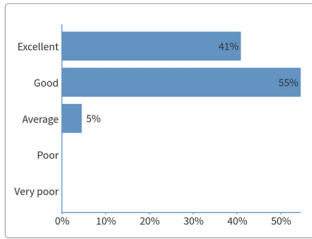

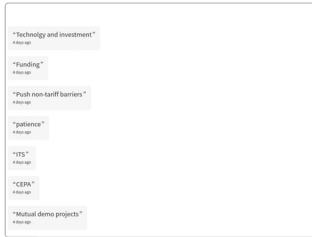
