



Current Waste Management Challenges

- Limited access to waste collection equipment;
- Limited access to the landfill;
- Limited financing;


Proposed Solutions

 - Recycling
 - Composting
- Outsourcing of Secondary Collection Chain
 - ► Collecting from Community Dump Sites
 - Transporting to and dumping at the landfill
