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Progress so far

- DGs meeting with HoCs in February: agreement to develop Joint Response Strategy (JRS) + DoL in fall 2010
- Action plan of 30 March
- Retreat of 13 EU donors + NO on 23 April
- Ethiopia: new PASDEP II + elections on 23 May

Action plan

- Consistency between individual strategies and JRS
- Lobbying government and Donor Assistance Group and reinforce harmonisation task force
- DoL at sector level
- Increase of joint/pooled funding (incl reconsideration of DBS fall 2010)
- Planning: agreement on JRS and framework end 2010; support consultant (delayed)

Retreat 23 April

- Agreement on definitions for role donors
- Gov and Rural: political and different treatment
- Four pilot sectors: HIV (IR), Env (NO), Rural (NL/EC), Gender (SE)
- Past 5 years 19 sectors exit; 2010 present in 38 (?) sectors (DAC 2008: 139)
