#### Paris Declaration on aid effectiveness

 Alignment by donors with partner country policies and systems and predictability

 Donor coordination, harmonisation and division of labour

Managing for results

.... are built on the fundament of sharing aid information by donors

## Accra Agenda for Action: aid transparency

- We will make aid more transparent
- Donors will publicly disclose regular, detailed and timely information on volume, allocation and, when available, results of development expenditure
- ... donors and developing countries will regularly <u>make public</u> all conditions linked to disbursements
- ... donors will provide <u>full and timely information on annual</u> commitments and actual disbursements ...
- .... donors will provide developing countries with regular and timely information on their <u>rolling three to five year forward</u> <u>expenditure and/or implementation plans</u>

# Current gaps in aid information


Information users require not available

When it is, not in in timely and accessible format

Fragmentation imposes high costs on both users and providers of aid information

- Donors have to deal with multiple requests
- Solutions: IATI as concept/standard and TR-AID as IT tool

#### Information tools & Aid databases

- Donor websites and annual reports
- DAC: CRS and CRS ++ (9-21 month time gap)

AidData: adds to CRS but still backward looking

Partner country Aid Information Management
 Systems (AIMS): manual data provision by donors

# What TR-AID is/is not

<u>Is not:</u> <u>Is:</u>

Communication and reporting tool (like CRS)

Professional tool for coordination purposes

Open to general public

Restricted to donors (on reciprocity basis)

Limited to predefined set of data

Gathering any operational data from donors

Requiring reformatting of data

Integrating data from any 'as is' format

Concept/standard (like IATI)

Tool/database

#### Added value of TR-AID

 Supports aid effectiveness agenda: division of labour (fast track), coordination/harmonisation, reduce fraud/ corruption

Provides technical tool, which is already worked out

- Can deal with rough data, so no additional work or fine tuning needed from aid information providers (donors)
- Provides save/secure environment to share data and experiment

#### Potential of TR-AID

Could build on IATI standard, once agreed

 Could further support: predictability and transparency to wider public (if/when opened up)

 Could contribute to EU operational framework on aid effectiveness (part of Mutual Accountability)

Potential EU deliverable in HLF IV/Korea on aid effectiveness
