Integrating Public Health research into the development priorities of Lao PDR

Backarour

The Lao Tropical and Public Health Institute (LaoTPHI) is mandated to provide the Ministry of Health with evidence-informed policy recommendations, to set the National Health Research Agenda (NHRA) and manage the research portal for the health sector. Further to this, LaoTPHI organises the annual National Health Research Forum (NHRF) to present the results of its research to health authorities at the Ministry, Provincial health departments, as well as development partners supporting the health sector in Laos.

In response, LaoTPHI have developed this NHRA, which is not only informed by the recommendations of the PIGA, but also includes a focus on the SDGs for nutrition and Sexual and Reproductive Health Rights (SRHR), with attention to equity, health financing, and costeffectiveness.








PhD Candidates

- 1. To determine the SRHR literacy among adolescents; gain insights into causes and consequences of teenage pregnancy and the potential of health literacy interventions in relation to SRHR
