






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Several layers with public and private commitments

Conclusions of the EU Council on CBD

A good step in the right direction!

- With the support of an **ambitious Beijing Agreement** with **voluntary commitments** and **review processes**

WWF demands for CBD:

- Zero net loss target in 2030 (eq of 2°C)
- Ratcheting mechanism
- Equivalent to NDCs for Nature including national and imported impact
