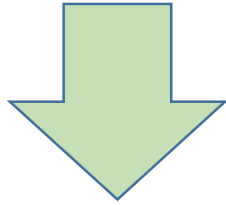

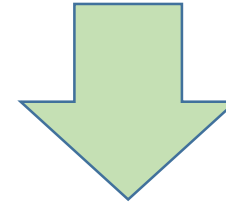

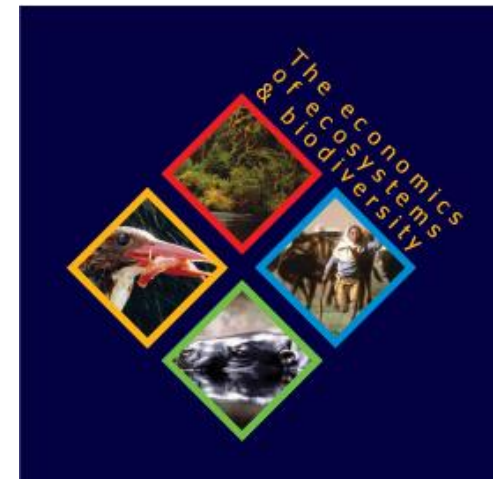

- 3. Mainstreaming (including greening investments)**
~ influencing the 96 % !
