
DRIVERS FOR URBAN FOCUS

- The world is becoming urban
- Concentration of challenges, many environmental:
 - Providing basic municipal services
 - Concentration of energy consumption and emissions
 - Increased exposure to disasters
 - Traffic congestion
 - Air quality
 - Solid waste management local authority responsibility
- But also essential element of structural transformation, economic development

European External Investment Plan

Sustainable cities:

- *AECID/WB on resilient cities*
- AfD intermediary lending – local banks to LA
- EIB layered funds broad urban scope
- + EBRD under energy window with city focus

Empowerment of Associations of Local Authorities at the regional and global level



Supporting Local Authorities in making human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable

- Call for proposals 2018-20
- Core element: City to city partnerships
- Regional lots



MULTI-COUNTRY THEMATIC FACILITIES

Targeting specific urban challenges in a range of countries, often providing support to development of strategies, project preparation etc.

National and Regional Envelopes

- A number of countries having urban projects under the NIP/RIP
 - Solid waste, Water supply/sanitation, Urban mobility
 - Very few on Urban Development
- Next Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF)
 - Aim: move towards integrated urban development
