

Checklist for editing / writing webpages

Recommended good practice – not all points may apply to every page.

Content

1. Who is the audience and is the content **relevant/interesting** to them?
2. Does the page have **just one subject** – and what is it?
3. Does it have an **intro paragraph that is a summary** of page's key idea (answering the basic questions: who, what, where, why, how, when)?
4. Is the **key information in the most prominent position** i.e. as close to the top of the page as possible?

Structure / Presentation

5. Are plentiful (sub)headings used?
6. Is **bolding** used to highlight key ideas in each paragraph? (max. 2 items per paragraph)
7. Are **paragraphs short**? (2-3 lines ideal – even 1 sentence is a great web paragraph)
8. Does each **paragraph have just 1 main idea**? And **max. 3 links**?
9. 3 or more items in running text should be a **bulleted list**
10. If the page is long, does it have **internal navigation links at the top**?

Optimisation for search engines

All of the following must be: short, meaningful, and include keywords (*at the beginning*)

11. **Title tag**
12. **Description**
13. **Links**
14. **Headings** (H1 etc. format used?)
15. **ALT tags**

Style

16. Is the content presented in an **objective** style, or is it verbose / hype / repetitive?
17. Is the page written in **simple, accessible language** (no jargon or unclear administrative/legal style)?
18. Is the content **as short as necessary** to convey its message?
