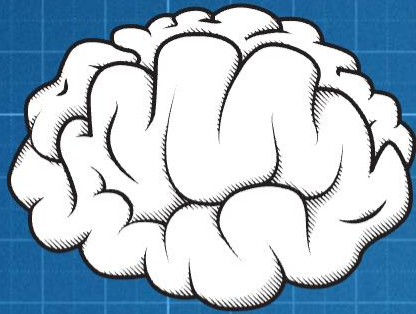

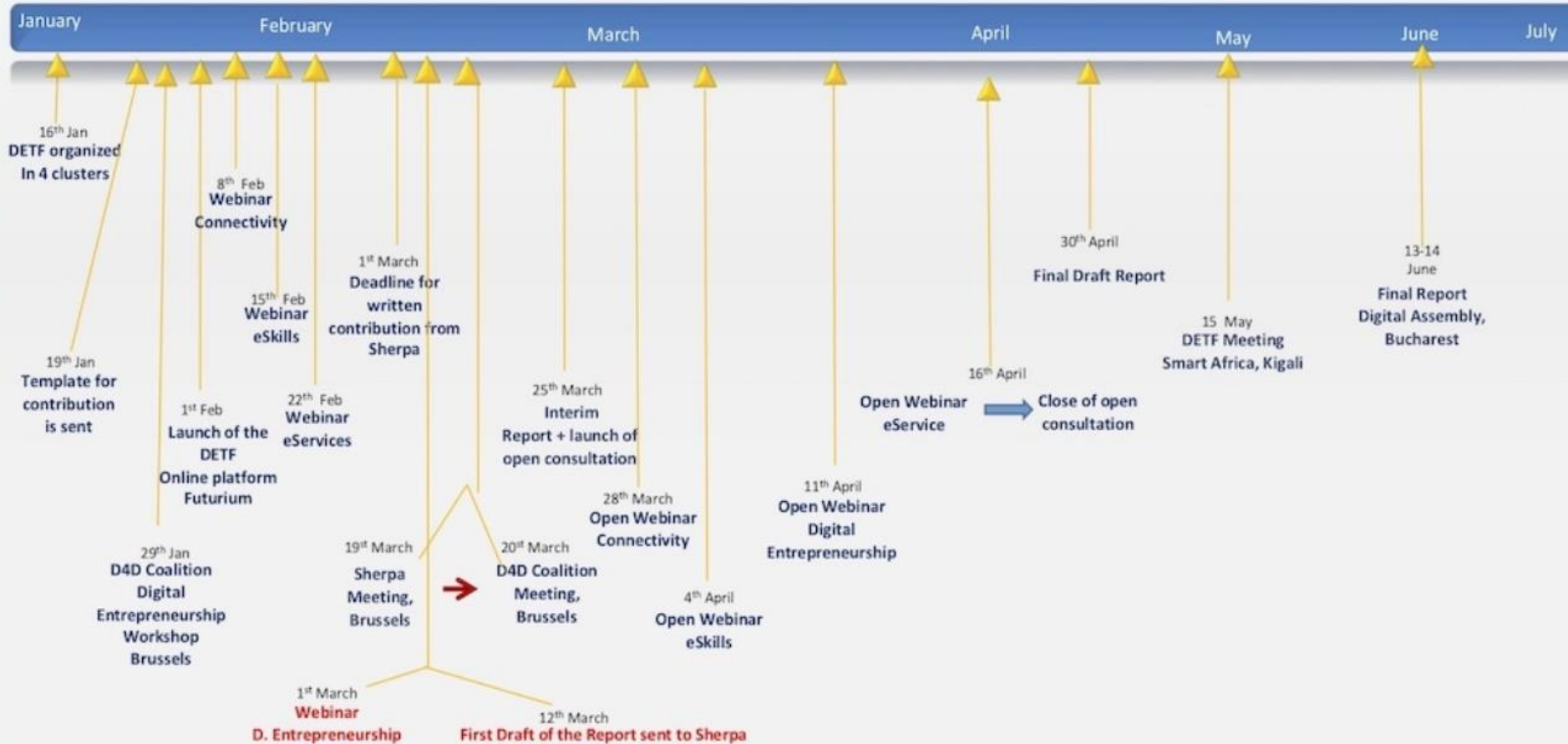

# 2019 DETF Timetable

- DETF members will work in parallel in 4 clusters representing the pillars of the report. A member can take part in more than one cluster.
- The Secretariat will circulate a template for concrete contributions. The Secretariat will comprise work already done by other organisations.
- The Secretariat will use the European Commission Futurium Platform to organise the online work of DETF and perform public consultations
- DETF work will be organised in a set of closed webinars (members and invited experts) and a set of open public consultations after the release of the interim report.
- The Sherpa meeting will be organised back to back with the D4D Coalition Meeting in Brussels
