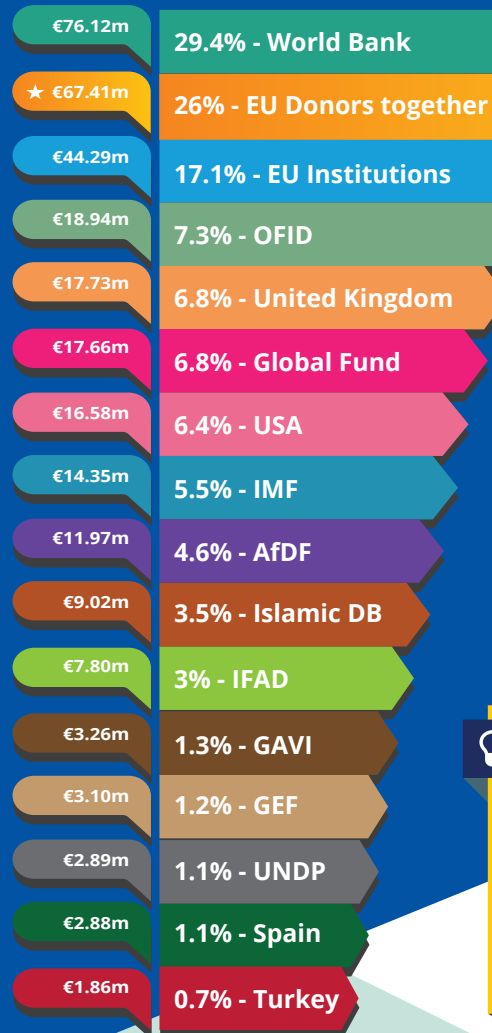




## Gambia largest donors in 2017

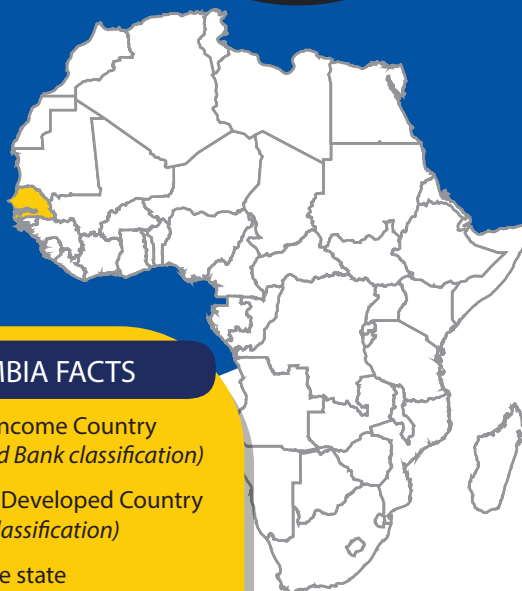
